"Learning on Location" enters Settlement with Utah Commerce Department
"Larry Webb to refund all customers or face original \$1.2 Million State fine"
(For immediate release...)

SALT LAKE CITY, Utah – Francine A. Giani, Executive Director of the Utah Department of Commerce, announced today that Larry Webb of "Learning on Location" and "International Studentours, Inc." has entered a Settlement Agreement with the Division of Consumer Protection. The Settlement Agreement stipulates Larry Webb must provide full refunds to 488 trip customers who did not receive services paid for through his business, pay a \$10,000 fine to the Division of Consumer Protection within a year of the signed agreement or face the original Citation fine amount of \$1.2 Million dollars.

"This Settlement with Learning on Locations is a positive step forward for hundreds of consumers," said Francine Giani, "We are pleased Larry Webb chose to work with Consumer Protection and is pledging to make good on his original contracts."

The Administrative Citation issued on July 20, 2006 against Larry Webb, "Learning on Location" and "International Studentours, Inc." assessed a fine of \$1,220,000.00 for deceptive business practices that violated the *Utah Consumer Sales Practices Act*. If Mr. Webb fails to comply with the Settlement Agreement, the State will reinstate the suspended portion of the fine without further hearing. This agreement does not affect civil claims or parties other than the Division or any other criminal, administrative or civil enforcement actions by any agencies having jurisdiction over the Larry Webb, his related companies and their actions.
